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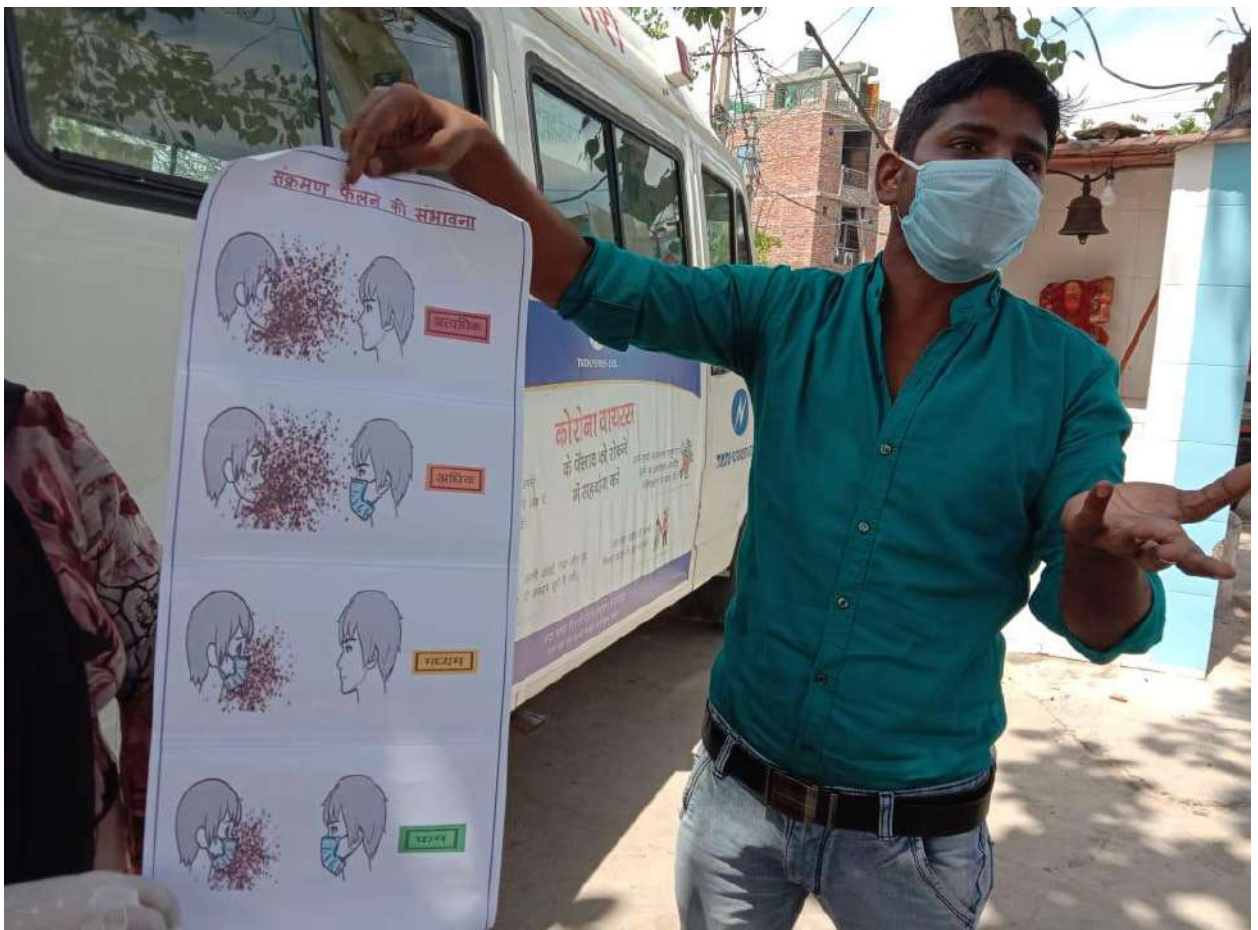

Organizing sessions on Positive attitude, Life skill education etc at Vocational Training centres..

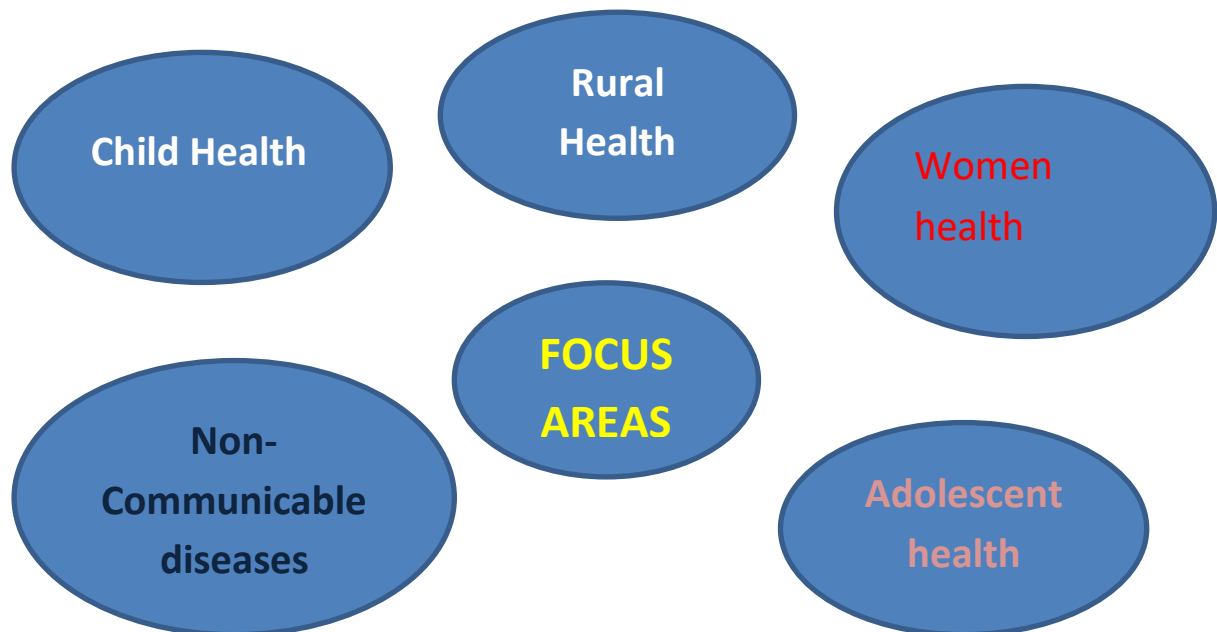
Women Empowerment - Legal issues related to dowry & domestic violence Educating Women to know the importance of health, parenting, work life balance etc

On-going project since 2015- “Mobile health at doorstep in J J Clusters, resettlement colonies and Rural areas in North and North-West areas of Delhi.”

Eduquest has been providing health services at doorsteps in JJ Clusters, Resettlement Colonies & Rural areas of TP-DDL operation through 5 mobile health dispensaries. The project is being funded by Tata Power Delhi Distribution Ltd (TP-DDL) since 2015.

From 2021-22 onward, TP-DDL has handed over the total responsibility of management and maintenance of all the 5 Mobile Dispensaries to Eduquest. Approx 800 beneficiaries have got treatment at doorstep every working day.



COVID-19 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic our focus on how to save the people from COVID-19. Being a health workers our objective also to aware the people on other diseases and their treatment. Off and on lockdown is going in the city due to the severity of the COVID-19 disease. Lots of causality has happened in the country/ world. Since last year people are living in the phobia of COVID-19 and now other diseases like Black fungus dreaded diseases also came up and people are suffering from this. Doctors are trying to treat them. The COVID-19 pandemic has had major effects on our lives. Many of us facing challenges that can be stressful, overwhelming and cause strong emotions in adults & children.



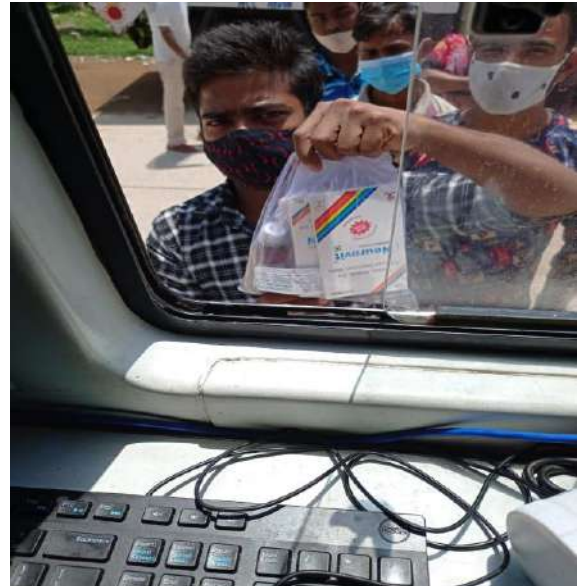
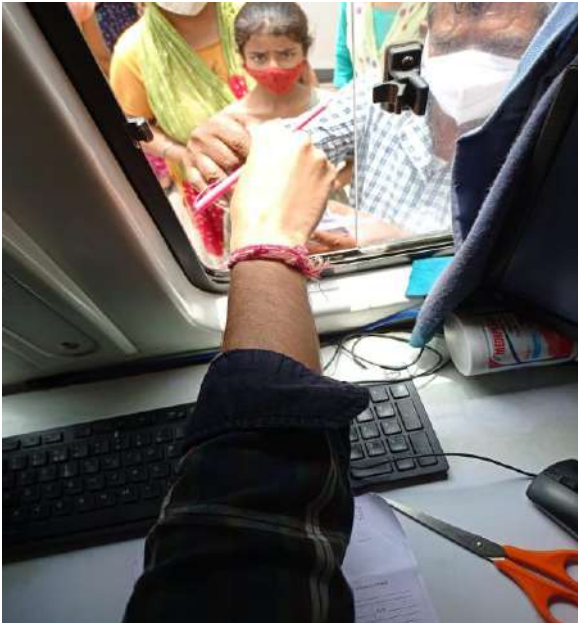
Most of people has lost their jobs some has lost their loved ones that cause them feeling of anger, sadness. Hopeless, frustrations etc. People suffering from poverty. The team of Eduquest comprises experienced Doctors, counselors providing them counseling on phone. Over medical and paramedical team organizing awareness on prevention from COVID-19 and other diseases as:

- Stay at home
- Keep safe distance of 2 meters but now the mutated variants of virus is light in weight and can travel more than 2 meters
- Don't spit, The virus is more lethal and double variant. More dangerous, Can remain in air for 3 hours. Now it is a air born diseases
- Frequent hand washing with soap and water or use alcohol based sanitizer
- Cover your face and proper wearing of mask on the face. Double must be use
- Avoid to visit crowd place and don't shake hands but say Namesty
- Use Elbow for cough and sneezing
- Thermal screening done for each and every patient attending the mobile dispensaries

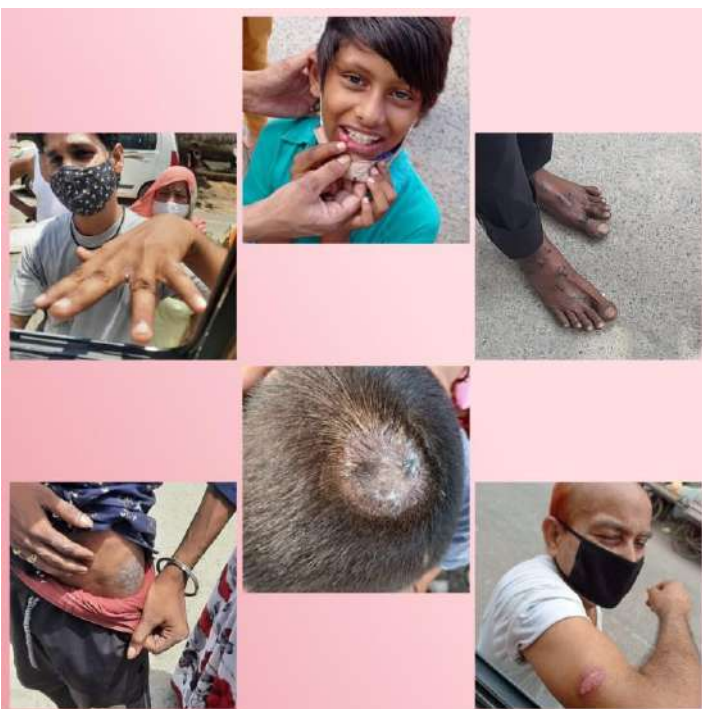
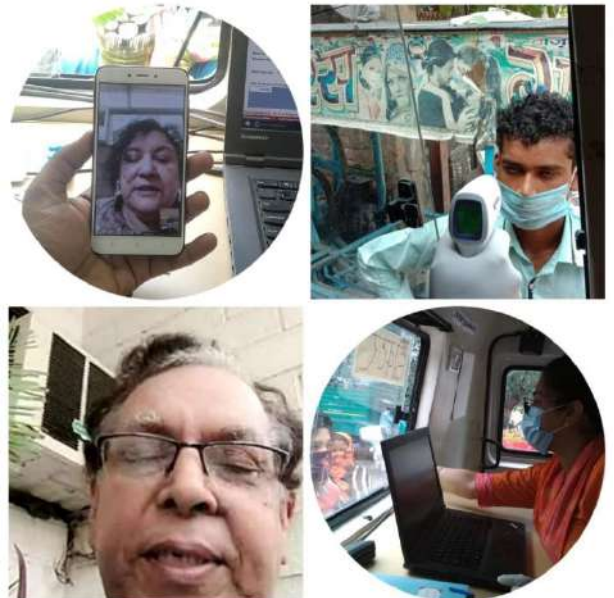
Donation of Oxygen Concentrator for serious patients in COVID-19 Pandemic

All the country grappled with second wave of Covid-19 virus, we have determined to make collective efforts to tide over this tough time together. In our humble effort with top management of Tata Power DDL extended our support to the Delhi Police an essential services provider like us Tata PowerDDL handed over 25 Oxygen Concentrator to Mr. Rajiv Ranjan Singh IPS, DCP Outer North District, Delhi Police. We believe we can all combat the crisis by lending each other a helping hand



Telemedicine:

The Doctors of EDUQUEST are providing treatment through Telemedicine. Our Paramedical team remain in Community. After video conference between patient, Doctor & Pharmacist The pharmacist has issued the medicine. We also providing the Covid care kits to the patients. The Medical staff was on duty 24 x 7. Any consultation desired by patients for Hospitalization, Signs & Symptoms of seriousness Regarding medicine dose etc. as we were working for Underprivileged community.



Arogya Project-

It started in 2019 in a J J Cluster and still continue. In COVID-19 pandemic. We provide Teleconsultation /Telemedicine treatment to the Children and pregnant women. New Registration is continue. This time the Covid-19 attack on children is more serious and lethal. We educate the parents for all precautions, distributed the Vit-D Drops, issued medicines for ailments from mobile dispensaries as per Telemedicines. Pregnant women also getting Cap Iron and Tab. Calcium.



Mask Distribution: Approx 20000 mask distributed in the community. Because this was the main preventive measure for Covid-19. We have educated people to proper wearing of maskd.



Nutrition Kit distribution

We have organized a “Nutrition Kit distribution Campaign” amongst the underprivileged, especially the undernourished mothers who in turn of giving birth to low weight babies /undernourished girls of the households of the JJ clusters under



Social Impact Group health initiative. The health products which were distributed in the community were Soya chunks, Ensure, Protenex, Women Health Horlicks are full of High protein, high calcium, Vitamins specially Vit D , Iron and minerals. These are very important to Human body. Every cell in the human body contains protein. The basic structure of protein is a chain of amino acids. We need protein in your diet to help our body repair cells and make new ones. The health products distributed at various locations i.e Udham singh park jj clusters, Shabad Dairy J J Clusters, Sultanpuri, Bawana j j clusters etc. We have Benefitted approx 4000 people in the areas. Material was purchased in bulk and distributed in such a way to help to maintain the health of women, adolescents and pregnant mothers. Pregnant mother were given a pkt of three products so she can at least use for four months. All the products distributed in good quantity to restore the health.



Sanitary Napkins distribution:

The reasons were as

- All schools across the country shut for months due to Coronavirus pandemic. The school girls can not avail the facility of free sanitary napkins
- Continuous taboos and restrictions related to menstruation
- Adolescent girls feeling anxiety for using cloth pads and how to manage menstrual hygiene management.
- Due to poverty can't afford high price of sanitary napkins
- In COVID-19 pandemic disrupted manufacturing of menstrual hygiene products
- Broken supply chain of menstrual hygiene products
- Many factories are shut



Women health- Rural health

The program was organized in Rural on women health. The topics included were

- Menstrual Hygiene management
- Breast self examination
- Personal hygiene
- Anemia



Problems faced by the health team during Covid-19 Pandemic:

- No Vehicle was available for commute in Lock-down. However Eduquest arranged free pick and drop services for the staff.
- Tremendous stress and other mental health problem felt 'Burn out'
- Fear of Covid-19 safety
- Family pressure on female staff for not to go on work in such environment. It was great phobia for family.
- Age related issues for senior doctors having other ailments like BP, Blood Sugar, CAD, Pulmonary disease etc
- People were not cover their faces even after repeated instructions



Awareness sessions on various subjects:

Our Medical and Paramedical staff have organized the awareness session on Hygiene, Menstrual Hygiene management, Early detection of breast cancer, Anemia, Pelvic inflammatory diseases, joint pain, cancer, Non communicable diseases, diabetes , No smoking etc.





Health Camps



Health camps were organized in Rural areas .The activities were done as

1. Consultation
2. Free medicine distribution
3. Investigations like Blood Sugar, Hemoglobin, Blood Pressure check-up
4. Counselling
5. Referral to higher centre if any for further management
6. Awareness sessions for prevention of various diseases.



Menstrual Waste Management:

Menstruation and menstrual products are still facing many social, cultural and religious restrictions which is a big barrier in the path of menstrual hygiene management and disposal of used material. There is a need to educate our citizens and make them aware about the environmental pollution and related health hazards , not just to human beings but also to stray animals especially our Holy cow. The implementation of modern techniques like proper segregation and incineration can help to reduce the waste. One survey of approx. 5000 people was done in the North and North west of Delhi and found every people Male , Female and Adolescent have gave their suggestion that this waste should be collected separately and managed accordingly by MCD in Delhi.

Inauguration of 5th Mobile van-

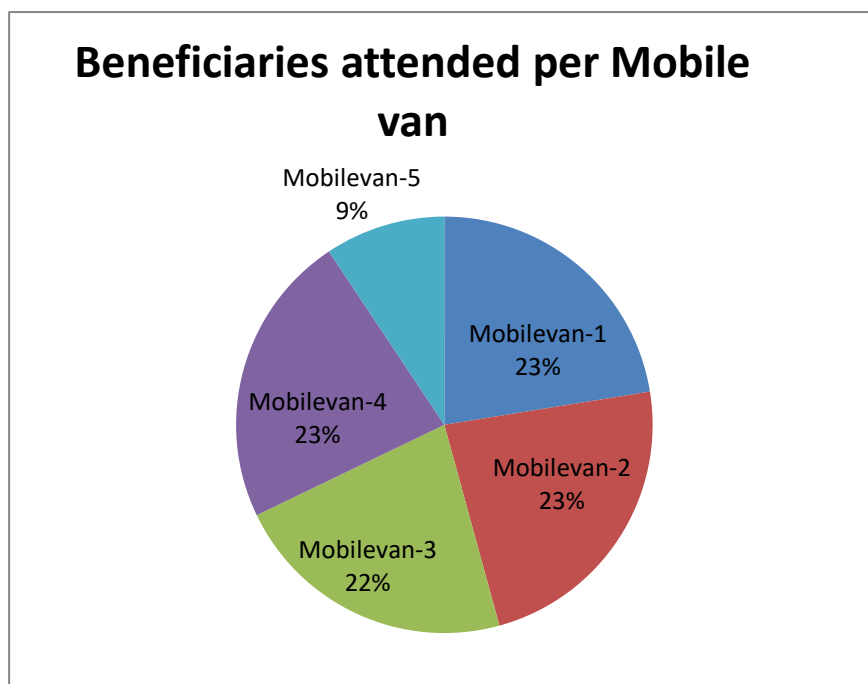
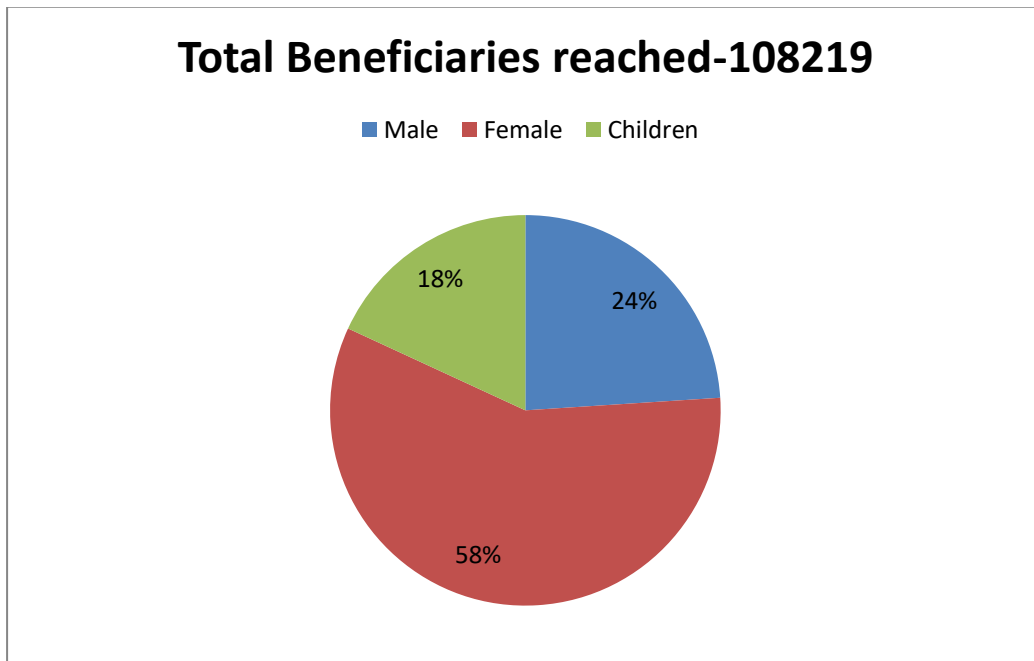
We have started our journey in 2015 one mobile van and now in July 2021 the 5th mobile van have donated to Eduquest by TATA Power DDL

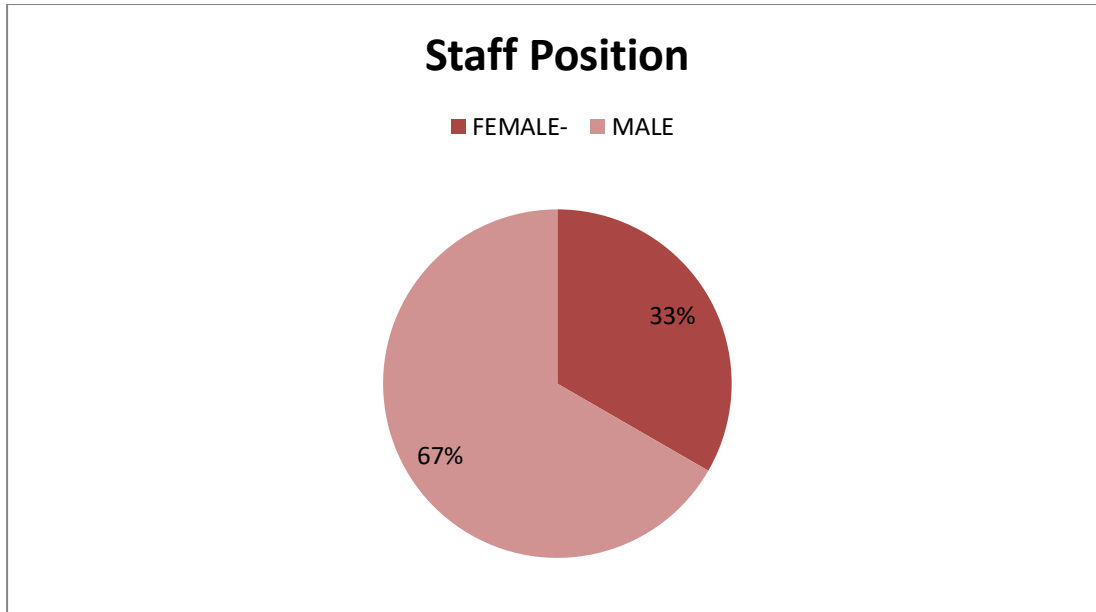

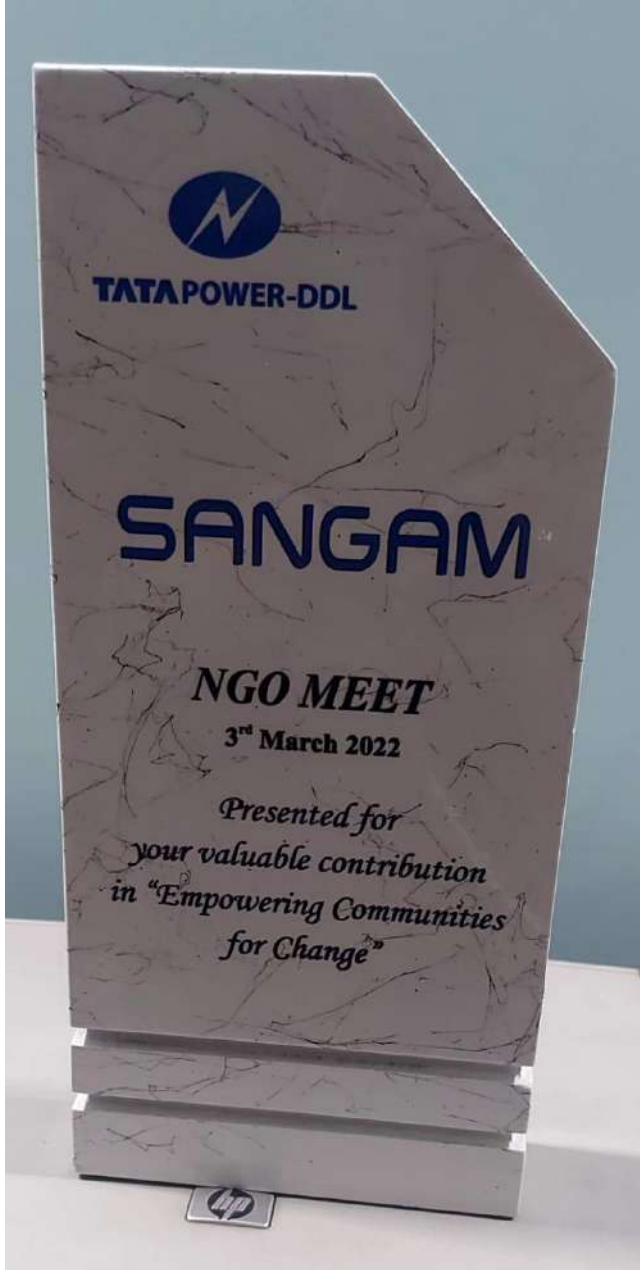
EDUQUEST currently runs 5 Mobile Dispensaries.

4. Driver-1

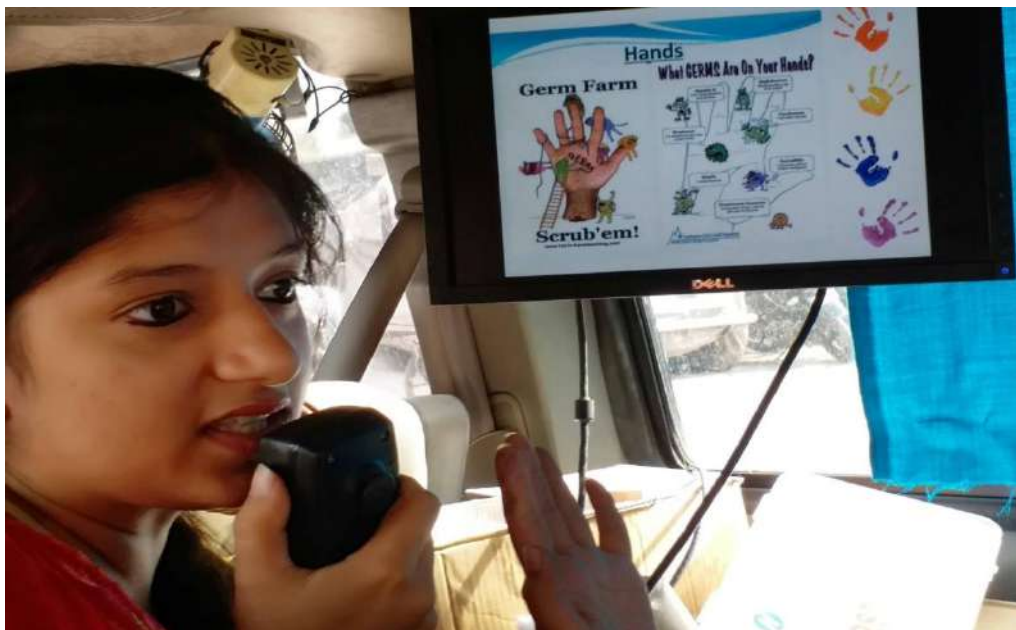
